NU Mermen Defeat Three Big Eight Meet Set This Week

Nebraska's swimmers will take a 9-4 record into the Big Eight championships at Norman, Okla., Thursday through Saturday.

The Huskers downed Pittsburg (Kans.) State, 57-34, Friday night and won a triangular from Grinnell and Kansas State Saturday at the Coli-seum Pool. Nebraska scored 761/2 points to 541/2 for Grinnell and 19 for Kansas State in the three-way meet.

In dual scoring Nebraska dropped Grinnell, 55½-33½, and Kansas State, 73-16. Grinnell thumped Kansas State, 61-23.

Two Nebraska records fell in Friday's dual and five marks were lowered Saturday as the Huskers had little trouble in winning either meet. Coach Dick Klaas's swim-

mers won 10 of 11 events in Friday night's rout of Pittsburg State. Doug Scherer stifled a Husker sweep when he won the 200-yard individual medley for the visitors.

Groth Sets Marks

Husker sophomore Jay Groth set records in winning both the 220 and 440-yard freestyle events. He lowered his own 220 mark one-tenth of a second with a 2:18.0 Phi Delta Theta-C 34 . clocking and bettered his 440 record by 7.5 seconds with a winning time of 4:53.9. Nebraska's track team fell at the hands of Oklahoma, Big Eight indoor champs, Saturday, 75-47, in the last meet of the indoor season. A stadium record and three meet records were toppled

by the Sooners as they scored firsts in all but three events. NERRASCI Oklahoma Misseuri Martin regained the stadium

pole vault record and broke the meet record of 15-34 as he vaulted 15-1%. After he set the record with relatively little difficulty Martin said, "That's the main reason I came up here."

Husker Jim Kraft finished second in this event with a 14-0 vault.

Martin pulled a double win by skimming the high hurdles in :07.6 with Husker Bill Fasano finishing close behind him.

Stevens Doubles

The Husker camp was not completely black as sophomore ace Ray Stevens pulled a double win in the mile and two-mile events. Stevens coasted to a mile victory over Lee Smith of Oklahoma in 4:20.8, his best mile mark.

Stevens also cut two-tenths of a second off his two-mile mark as he again outlasted




