

Cornhuskers Debut Tomorrow; Devaney Uses Experienced Unit

Bob Devaney, Husker football coach, makes his debut in Memorial Stadium tomorrow at 2 p.m., putting an experienced Cornhusker squad on the field against South Dakota.

Only one sophomore, Doug Tucker, is on the top two units with the first team comprised solely of lettermen.

The starting team has a line which averages 204 pounds and a backfield that averages 192 pounds.

Dwain Carlson, senior co-captain, who has been running on the first unit at left guard, has injured his toe but

Ross (185) at left half, Gene Young (197) at fullback and Rudy Johnson (185) at right half.

Johnson's availability is questionable. If he is unable to play, Kent McCloughan (190) will move into his spot. McCoughan will also play defense with the first unit, replacing the quarterback.

In case Carlson is unavailable, Kirby will move to the starting unit and John Devan (185) will move to the second unit.
