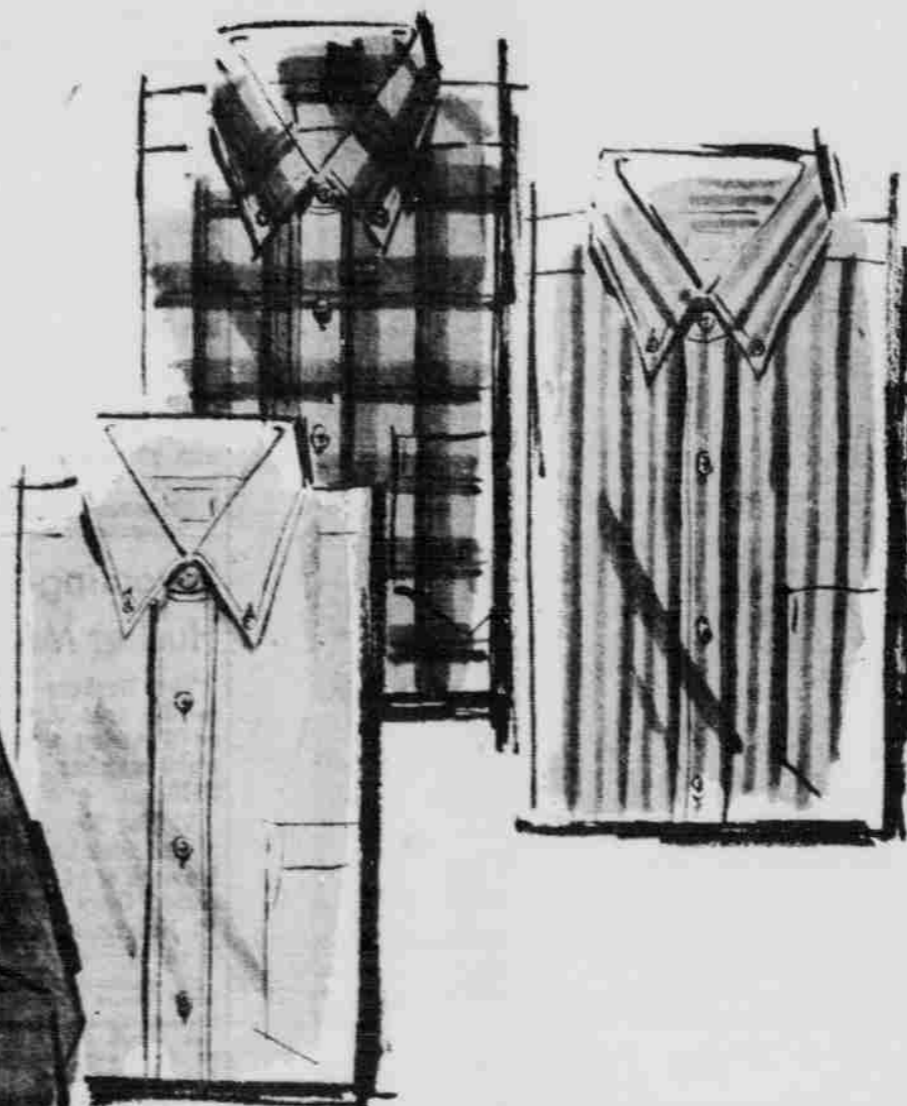
The program includes: "Quartet in A minor, Opus 29," by Schubert; a cantata,
