

## Where the Action Is

That is what's bothering many people who are concerned about the construction workers' strike in Lincoln now.

The strike has completely stopped work on all University construction including the 12,000 seat addition to Nebraska's Memorial Stadium.

Work on the huge structure had just started when the strike was called. The supporting columns were just being poured when work was halted.

### Completion Uncertain

A question looms in the minds of many. Will the stadium be completed in time for the 1966 season?

"We have always had the same policy. We do not sell tickets for any game unless there is a board available for someone to sit on," Jim Pittenger said. "We won't send out any confirmations of tickets until we are positive that the stadium is completed."

Pittenger said that the University has always acted under the assumption that something could go wrong during construction that would cause billing problems. "An architect can draw up beautiful plans but a contractor can find that he faces a problem unless a number of seats are removed. Therefore we don't make any commitments unless we are sure," he said.

### Sellouts

At present, the University foresees no problems with the halted work on the stadium. But if the strike continues, the ticket office staff will have one large headache to face.

There are over 5000 requests for season tickets for the 1966 season waiting to be confirmed. If completion of the stadium is delayed these seats will not be available.

Pittenger explained that the 1966 football season is a sellout if "the stadium isn't ready by the opening game"—Texas Christian on Sept. 17.

"If the addition isn't ready by the opening game then we must assume that

it wouldn't be ready for the second game which is the following week (Utah State). If that happens, then we have enough orders now to declare those games sell-outs," he said.

If such a delay would materialize, the contractor would have an extra month to finish the work in time for the Nebraska-Missouri game on Oct. 29—already a sell-out on paper.

Things are too indefinite to draw any conclusions now, and Pittenger summed things up when he said, "No one will know for sure until the end of August, then we'll start worrying!"

Joe Cipriano is quite happy with the 1966-67 schedule for the Husker cagers.

Husker fans will be able to form an early opinion of the Cornhuskers better than before. The Huskers have five non-conference home games before they travel to Nashville, Tenn. for the Vanderbilt Invitational. The only non-conference road game will be with Wyoming on Dec. 7.

The tournament at Nashville will feature Vanderbilt, LaSalle, Portland University and the Huskers. It will take place only a week and a half before the Huskers make their conference debut in the Big Eight Holiday Tournament in Kansas City, Dec. 27-31.

"The Vanderbilt tournament will give us that needed experience before we head down to K.C." "Slippery Joe" said. There's no doubt that the Huskers will be out to get that tournament trophy.

"I think it is important to note that this will be the first time in a long time that Nebraska has had a 26 game schedule.

The game with Prague University of Poland will give our boys added game experience although it won't count on our won-loss record," Cipriano explained.
