# Winless Wildcats Battle Huskers On Saturday

The Nebraska Cornhuskers, after blossoming to near greatness last week against Wisconsin, 31-3, following three games of mediocracy, hope to show an anticipated Memorial Stadium crowd of 64,000 Saturday that they are as good or better than the sixth place rankings they now hold in both the UPI and AP ratings.

The winless Kansas State Wildcats are the Homecoming adversaries that must step in Nebraska's path just as the "Big Red" appear to be gaining momentum.

The Wildcats have dropped four games to Army, New Mexico, Colorado, and Missouri by a total of 72 points. They have little to put up against Nebraska other than the Big Eight's leading ground gainer Cornelius Davies who has rushed for a 6.1 vard average this season.

If on Saturday, Davis can come anywhere near keeping up the pace he has set so far, the Kansas State fullback gets our prema-ture vote for the Big Eight Back of the Week.

The K-State flash will be running into a Nebraska defense which ranks second in the nation in rushing yardage allowed to opponents. In games to date, the "Black Shirts" have

vards, or 38.5 yards a game which is about two yards more than has been allowed by Southern Mississippi.

Nebraska could show the anticipated record crowd Saturday that it has in Harry Wilson and Ben Gregory possibly the best onetwo punch in the back-field since Coach Bob Devaney came to Nebraska.

The running of Gregory and Wilson demoralized Wisconsin for 151 yards last week and that effort came just as Wilson appears to be rounding into shape. As for Gregory, it was his first starting assignment on offense after seeing mainly defensive duty in Nebraska's first three games.

been nudged for 147 rushing pass completions in one game (16); most pass completions for one season (62): most career passing yardage (2.149 yards); most career pass completions (150); and most career touchdown passes (15).

> Churchich is leading the Big Eight in passing yard-age this year with 454 yards in four games.

Nebraska has another Big Eight leader in safety Larry Wachholtz. The diminutive extra point and field goal kicker leads the league in scoring with 25 points and in punt returns with a 12.6 yard average.

Two bowl representatives will be in town Saturday and might add incentive for good showing on Nebraska's part in the still young season. Sugar Bowl representatives Dr. Fred Wolfe and Theo Maumus, both of New Orleans, will watch the Homecoming game.
