Huskers Add Spirit To Preparations

The Nebraska Cornhuskers, a team that has gained a reputation of playing unemotional but dead serious football, might be trying to fire things up a little for this Saturday's encounter with Colorado.

"We've always had a lot of hustle and spirit in practice," said Husker Coach Bob Devaney Wednesday, but he added that the Huskers have shown "a little additional spirit" in preparation for the Buffa-

It might come in handy because the Buffs appear to have caught fire last Saturday when they beat Iowa State 41-21 and took over the Big Eight rushing lead in the process, Colorado has run for a 208.6 yard average in the last five games compared to Nebraska's

But the Huskers lead the Big Eight in rushing defense, allowing five opponents an average of 46.6 yards on the ground, which could make for a hardfought contest at Boulder.

Nebraska has been hampered by injuries so far this season, but there was a bright note Tuesday.

Senior defensive halfback Kaye Carstens, who injured a knee last Saturday against Kansas State, was running with the "Black Shirts" and is expected to be ready for

But the status of right end Dennis Richnafsky and halfback Ron Kirkland doesn't look so good. Devaney said Tuesday that both Kirkland and Richnafsky would be sidelined for two more weeks and they would "definitely miss" the Missouri game Oct. 29th in Lincoln.

Devenay didn't hint that the Huskers would try anything new against the Buffaloes. There was some preseason talk that Nebraska would run from the I Formation but it has not yet materialized.

"We feel we can get just as much out of our other formations," said Devaney, "We haven't been working too much with the I Formation. We'll probably do many of the same things we have been doing, but we hope to do them better."
