Only five University coeds came to listen to AWS presidential candidates debate on AWS 'key' issues and campaign platforms Thursday.

Nancy Eaton, the only sophomore candidate, stated, "It has been said that AWS is only a puppet of the administration. But now the newly ratified constitution has a chance to make AWS a meaningful organization."

Asked if she felt that these changes were in the realm of AWS jurisdiction, Miss Neumeister said, "Other campus organizations aren't doing anything about these problems. AWS should be making concrete recommendations to the administration."


