## Bonfire sparks off Homecoming

The 1968 Homecoming weekend kicks off Thursday, Nov. 7 with a bonfire pep rally. Joe Voboril, Homecoming Chairman for Corn Cobs, announced.

He said that Governor Norbert Tiemann will present the ten Homecoming Queen finalists at the pep rally. The finalists will be announced in the Oct. 31 issue of the Daily Nebraskan.

**THE QUEEN** and her attendants will be elected by popular vote of the student body on Nov. 6. The finalists were chosen by Corn Cob and Tassels members.

A spirit trophy will also be awarded at the pep rally, Voboril announced.

Entries for the Homecoming display contest will be judged Friday, Nov. 8

between 5 and 7 p.m. There will be trophies given to the top three displays with honorable mention winners given plaques, he added.

**THE DISPLAYS** will be judged on the basis of originality and development of the theme, said Voboril. The Homecoming game will

be played with Kansas State University.

Coronation of the Homecoming Queen and announcement of display winners will take place at the Homecoming dance Friday, Nov. 8, he said.

## Singers to lead series

The Camerata singers were formed in 1960 by New York's Lincoln Center. Since then they have appeared regularly in New York. This is their first national tour and will take them to thirty-six cities over a six-week schedule.

The youthful members of the Camerata Singers represent a cross section of America. For this tour the group's director, Abraham Kaplan, has prepared his singers in a program of widely varied music from Omaha Kickers 6-0 and the Omaha Pioneers 5-0.

"We're really improved a lot since our first two games," he said. "This week off will give us a chance to work out the problems that we have had."
