

VISTA looks for specialists

Volunteers In Service To America has new vistas in this year's recruitment drive — it is scanning the campus for specialists.

VISTA is seeking more skilled graduates, such as architects and lawyers.

"One reason for recruiting specialists is that 80 per cent of all volunteers have attended college," said Shirley Byrd, one of three VISTA workers recruiting volunteers at the University, Feb. 9-13.

The other recruiters are Alice Shands, a Mississippi volunteer who has worked in the Des Moines ghetto, and Rebecca Salazar, a California volunteer who has worked with migrant workers in her home state.

The recruiters will be speaking to classes, showing films and meeting as many people as possible.

"Past results of recruiting in Nebraska are encouraging," Miss Byrd said. Last year VISTA recruiters accepted nearly one-hundred applications at the University of Nebraska.

"There are no entrance re-

quirements or examinations," Miss Byrd said. Selection of volunteers is made on the basis of the quality of the application and upon the feedback of the applicant, she said.

The tenure for the VISTA volunteer is one year. After that male volunteers are again subject to the draft. Most male volunteers have occupational deferments which are issued by local draft boards, she said.

"Since VISTA began operation in 1965, more than 400,000 letters expressing interest in

the organization have been received, and nearly 14,000 Americans have become volunteers," Miss Byrd said.

The demand for volunteers outpaces the supply. In 1969, there were requests for 30,000 volunteers on a national scale," Miss Byrd said. She also said that "in Nebraska during 1969, there were requests for more than 200 volunteers to work on 21 different projects.
