"I chose speech pathology because I wanted to help people," Mrs. Wilson said. "When I was just teaching others to do therapy, I found that I had no time for the work myself."

Judy Coon, a graduate student in speech pathology, is also working in the program. She tries to stimulate the use of language through music.

"I was a music major and hated to leave it," Miss Coon said. "Then I discovered that speech therapy and music can work well together."

Through the use of simple vocabulary songs, she gets the four children in her group to respond.

She said that the group is now working with songs about life on the farm. Most of the children can now respond with "cow" and "moo", she added.

"I just love the work," Miss Coon said. "It's a very personal thing. At the least little response from a child, I can really get excited."
