

# Jim Koch injured at University rodeo



A University of Nebraska student was severely kicked in the saddle bronc competition at the final performance of the University of Nebraska's 12th annual rodeo.

Jim Koch, who had been granted a re-ride in the competition, was injured after being thrown from his mount. Although he was hospitalized overnight, Koch sustained no injuries.

Black Hills State College, Spearfish, S.D., won the boy's division of the rodeo at the final performance Saturday night.

The South Dakota cowboys compiled 548 points with Iowa State University placing second

with 279. The University of Nebraska team finished third with 243 points.

High individual honors were won by several University of Nebraska team members including John Sennett and Randy Radant who placed first and second respectively in the ribbon typing event. T. J. Peters won first place in steer wrestl-

ing and Linda Whitaker won first place in the girl's breakaway roping.

The Kansas State University girl's team won first place in the girls division with 234 points. Black Hills State placed second with 170 points and the National College of Business of Rapid City, S.D., placed third with 139.

Bill Larsen of Black Hills State won all-around cowboy honors with 161 points. Tying for second and third were Chuck Balvanz of Iowa State and Tom Miller of Black Hills State with 129 points each.

Patti Mattox of Kansas State won all-around cowgirl honors with 120 points followed by Vicki Dahl of Black Hills State with 115 and Kathy Kary of the University of South Dakota with 75 points.

Ribbons and trophies were

handed out by Jane Cromwell of Genoa, the newly-named 1970 NU Rodeo Queen.

Other schools competing were North Dakota State University, Peru State College, University of South Dakota and Kearney State College.

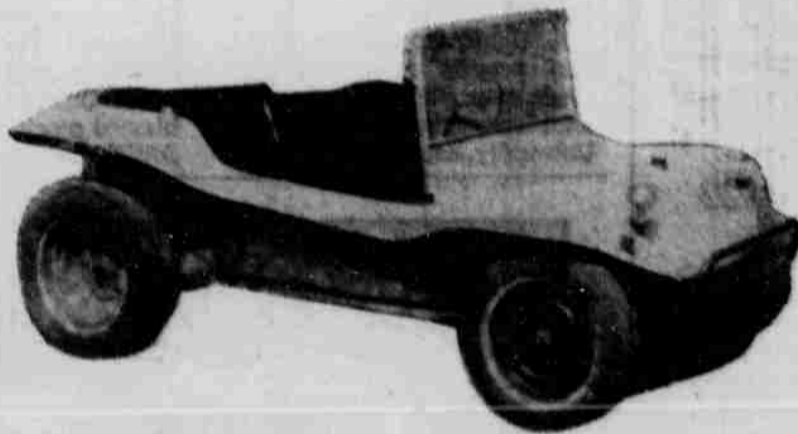
