

Figures soar in Vietnam

WASHINGTON — (CPS) — Total U.S. deaths in the Indochina war have climbed to 52,061, according to latest figures from the U.S. Department of Defense. This includes 43,568 deaths "resulting from action from hostile forces," and 8,493 from other causes, such as helicopter accidents. 114,096 Saigon government troops have been killed, along with 4,060 other U.S. allies.

The Defense Department claims 668,674 North Vietnamese and NFL soldiers have lost their lives, bringing the death total for the war to 839,091, not including civilians and numerous troops in Laos and Cambodia.

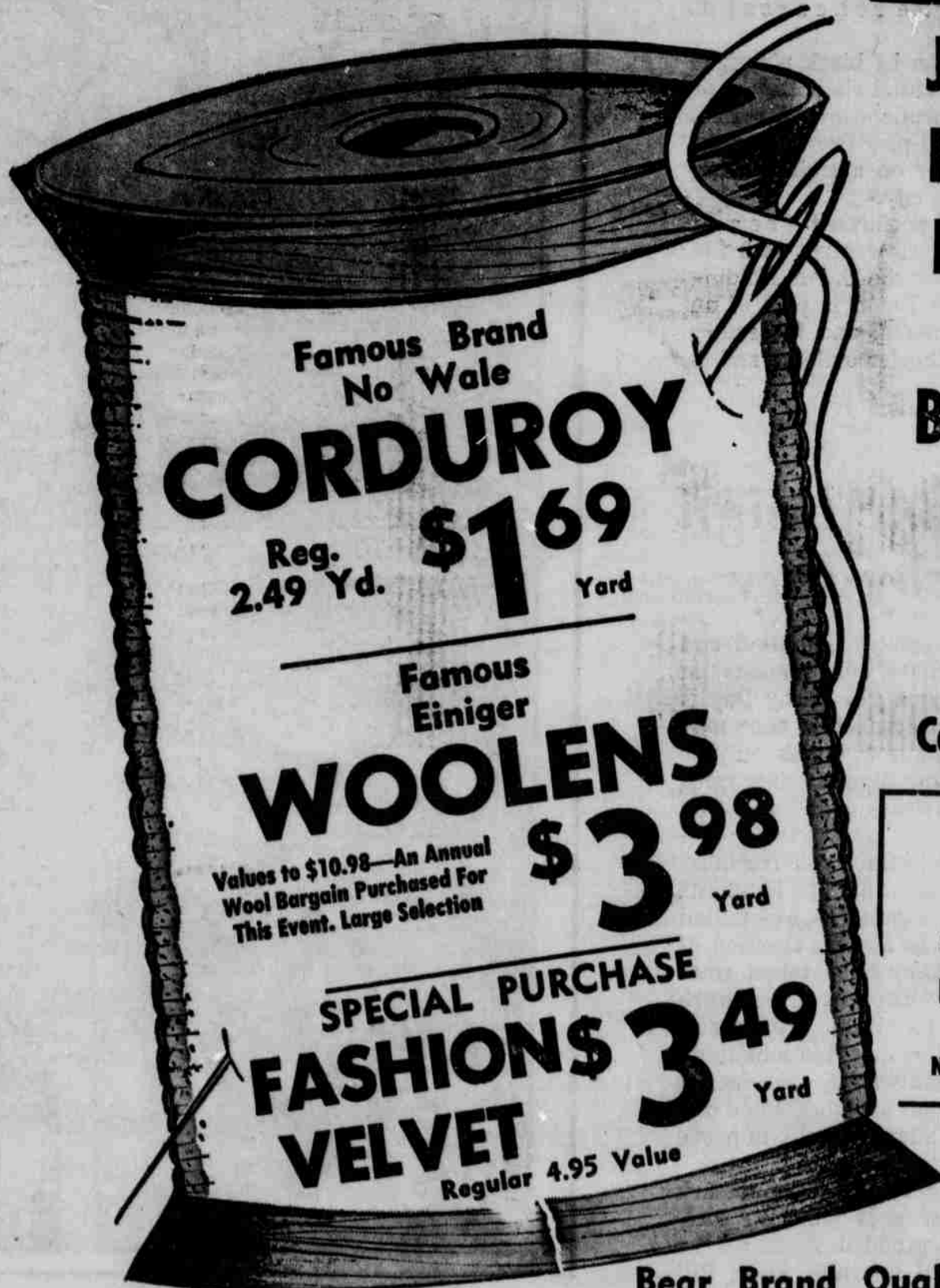
