

School bus boggles, limps to Lincoln

A 1957 Chevy school bus needs the help of University students.

The green bus with a white roof needs a \$75 valve job. Jordan, one of its occupant-owners, said. The suffering bus must have a transplant of cylinders 4 and 6 on the intake drives.

Two friends of Jordan played for a small group of University students in the Nebraska Union Wednesday afternoon to raise cash. "Help! Our bus is broken down (spare change appreciated)," read the sign on a Stetson hat.

Jordan and his friends were part of a caravan of about 300 traveling around the country. Their bus of people had just made a side-trip to Colorado and were on the way to catch the rest of the caravan in Des Moines.

The green bus broke down in Grand Island, according to Jordan. He added that the bus "limped" to Lincoln where the

group now hopes to repair the vehicle.

The caravan transports Steve Gaskin, "a cat" who started the "Monday Night Class" in San Francisco about four years ago. The class was a rap session.

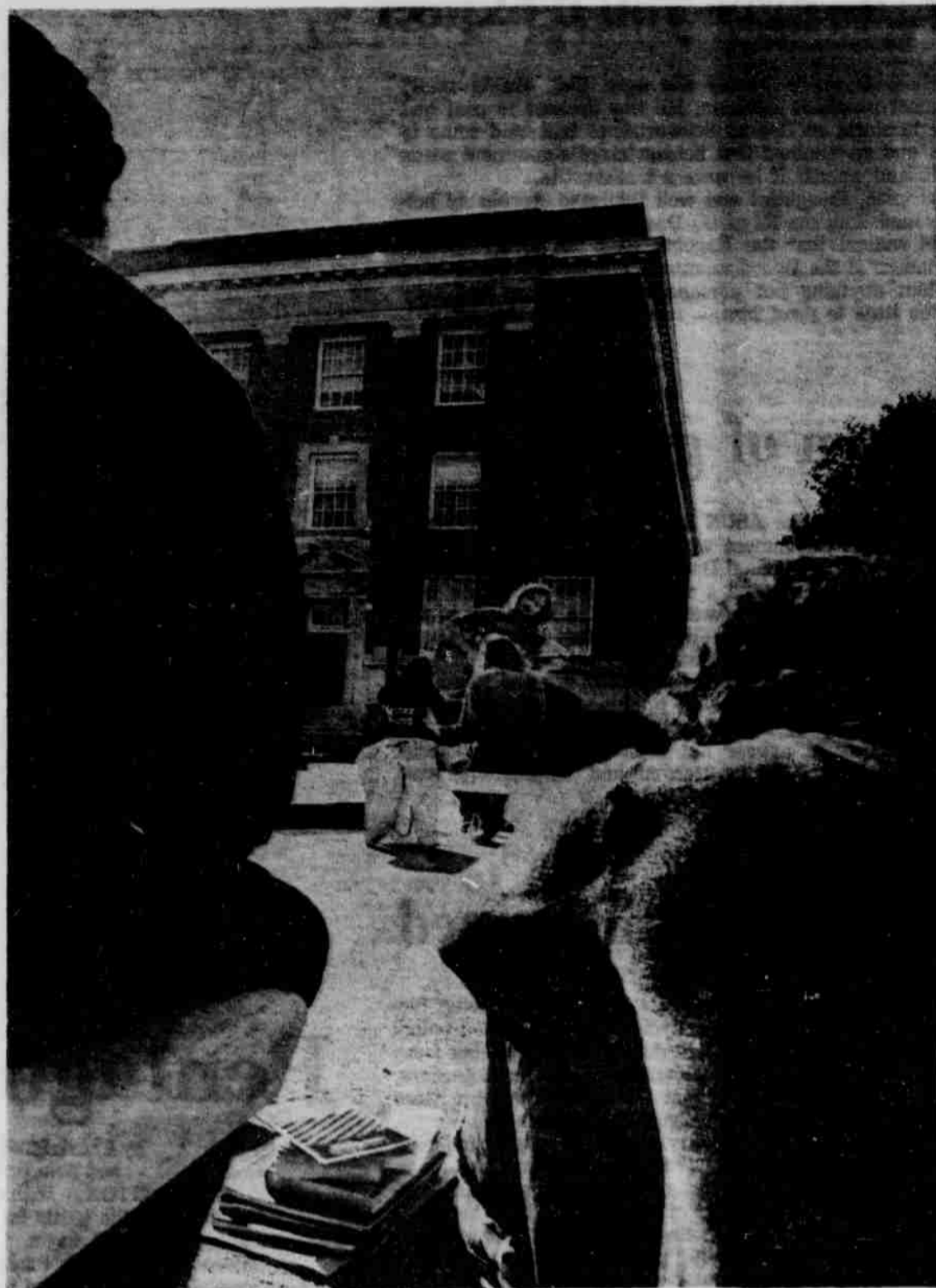
Gaskin is now speaking wherever someone "says for sure that he can come and speak," Jordan said.

"The group wants to show people that long-hairs are not freaky or scary," he added. "We also want to turn people on, anyone who's ready."

Jordan explained that Gaskin usually states some of his views and then invites anyone in his audience to ask questions.

"We get questions like 'what's love?' and 'what do you mean by life?'" Jordan said.

The caravan has not been invited anywhere in Nebraska, he noted, but might stop in on its way back to San Francisco if invited.
