The course will cover managing, feeding, housing, breeding, shoeing and riding, Warren said. He is a nationally approved American Horse Show Association senior registered judge.

Near the end of the semester, he said, intra-class equitation, or riding competitions will be neld. The equitation training

includes saddle, blanket, stirrup and rein adjustment. grooming, riding positions, types of gait, basic dressage movements, and some advanced riding and jumping. Safety precautions and care
