make a decision. He said he expects a final decision by Friday.

Parties may be represented by counsel. Those who are not students will not be required to go before the Tribunal, Gierhan said. But, he added that they may want to appear because they may want to become students again in the future.

He said there was a possibility the University will place a hold on the non-student's registration if they should try to register again. "We have to look at all the legal implications." Gierhan added.

Concerning the students who were pladed on probation, Gierhan said they would probably appear before the Tribunal "at some future date." As of yet the time is not determined.


The Tribunal will recommend whether they should be taken off probation status or if sanctions should be applied. he said.


