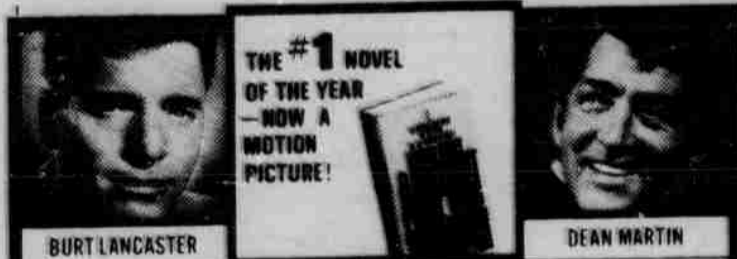

NU thinclads face NCAA competition

Big Eight athletes are hoping to reap a bountiful harvest of national honors this weekend at the NCAA Track and Field Championships at Detroit, Mich.

Defending team champion Kansas could repeat but will receive competition from eastern power Villanova. KU's Karl Saib, college track's premier shot putter, should win his specialty with little difficulty. If he does it will be his third national indoor title in a row.

Colorado boasts another pre-meet favorite in Marcus Walker. Walker has proven himself the fastest indoor hurdler in the United States this winter.

Nebraska will be entering eight athletes in four events. According to Coach Frank Sevine the Huskers' best chance of winning an event will be the triple jump where both Hopeton Gordon and Wes Leonard could battle for the title.

NU's two-mile relay team is one of only six invited to compete in the NCAA track meet. The young squad is made up of freshmen Roger Chadwick, Dan Speck, Larry Cimato, and sophomore Jim Hawkins.

Greg Carlberg will be entered in the mile run, after qualifying on the strength of his 3:59.6 three weeks ago at the Houston Federation Meet. Carlberg missed workouts this week due to a cold but is expected to be ready this weekend.

Nebraska is represented in the 600-yard run by Garth Case, who will be trying to make up for his defeat to Kansas State's Dale Alexander in the Big Eight Meet.

Rifle club hosts shoot tourney

The University rifle club will host its 18th annual Big Red Rifle Tournament at the Military and Naval Science Building Friday through Sunday.

Competitors are expected from Wisconsin, Missouri, Kansas, Iowa, Oklahoma, South Dakota, North Dakota and Nebraska. There are 32 teams entered from 15 schools.

Action gets underway Friday noon.
