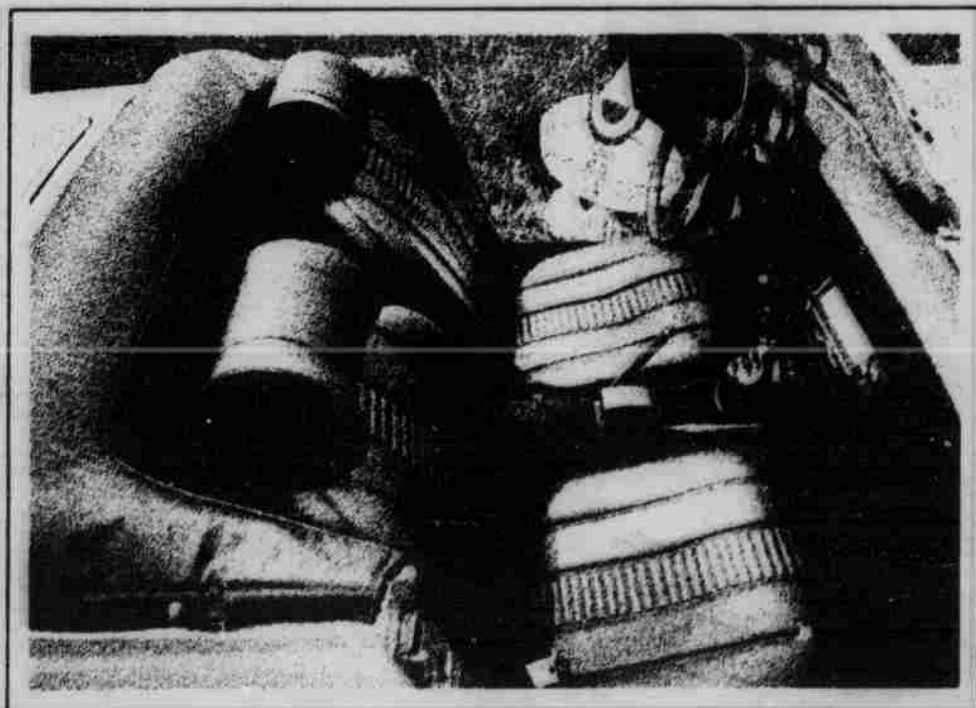


**You can afford it while
