Continued from page 2. by the committee, which is writing a new constitution for UNL.

The disputed point provided for "adequate time and full opportunity" for discussion of the final report of the committee before it is sent to the Board of Regents. Students, faculty, administrators and the Board of Regents could "read, discuss, debate, comment upon, and suggest changes,

deletions, additions, or alterations."

John Braemen, history professor, contended that all things affecting the faculty should be submitted to the faculty for approval before submission to the Board of Regents.

An extended discussion ensued before Braemen's argument was defeated.
