Students have appeal option

Small-time lawbreakers and general scofflaws, take note. The UNL system of justice provides a course of appeal for anybody who feels he or she has wrongfully received a parking ticket.

Howard Epstein, chairman of the ASUN Parking Appeals Committee, said the committee meets twice monthly to consider appeals. He outlined the procedure to be followed in an effort to "make students aware we exist."

An individual who has received a ticket can fill out an appeal form at the campus security office. The appeal is then considered by the five-member board.

The individual can also make a personal appearance before the committee. The committee rules on the appeal and makes a recommendation to the office of Student

Epstein said the appeal should be filled by the Wednesday before the regular meetings. The committee meets on the first and third Thursday of each month.
