Service, headed by Prof. Henry M. Cox, evaluates questions for educational validity. The simplest process is to tabulate students responses to determine relative difficulty.

A second criterion contrasts the scores of those students who do well on the exam with those who do the poorest, determining how well the question differentiates between responses.

In the Counseling Center, their patient load usually slackens around finals time, Counselor John Winkworth said.

The center helps students alleviate test anxiety and nerves through relaxation techniques. A tense mental state corresponds with muscle

tenseness, he said: relaxing muscle groups can help students to reduce anxiety.

Many students experience exam nerves and corresponding physical symptoms, but student health has not experienced a surge of patients during finals, according to psychiatric nurse Carol Helm.

Many who come up to dead week are not sure how to deal with anxiety, but after that week, finals are a reality that patients must deal with, Helm said.

Health center personnel help students consider the possibility of failure and make realistic plans for the future.

Crisis health aids, 472-2200, also help students consider alternatives, Helm said.
