Legislature moves construction bill

The Unicameral Appropriations Committee voted to advance its capital construction recommendations to the floor of the Legislature at a Wednesday noon meeting.

The committee accepted without change the fiscal staff's recommendations for the UNL campus. No funds in the proposal were designated for the construction of a new building for the College of Law.

Of the \$4.9 million recommended for the UNL campus, \$3.3 would go for the addition to Love Memorial Library. A new home economics building on East Campus would receive \$1.4 million in state funds.

The remaining \$190,000 recommended by the committee was for the remodeling of Ferguson Hall.
