Although not listed as an official student activity, "Casey's on P St." has, over the years, drawn its share of students.

"Casey's," as it's better known, is one of the most popular pubs that cater to those in their 20's, according to owner Earl "Casey" Christensen.

Now, however, after 22 years at 1115 P St., "Casey's" is moving. The lease has expired on the establishment, Christensen said.

The new "Casey's Other Place" is scheduled to open May 1 at 1020 P St. The new building is four feet wider and nearly 10 feet longer.

"Some people will have to walk half a block farther, for others it's half a block shorter," Christensen said.

He noted it has just been the last several years that the younger consumer of alcoholic beverages has patronized his establishment.

"It's the kids that make it 'Casey's,'" black, white Christensen said. "Casey Christensen said."
