After examining Evans' salary and those of other agricultural economists, the committee concluded that "Professor Evans is at present seriously underpaid."

The committee recommended that Evans' salary be reviewed immediately "with a view or providing a substantial increase to a figure more nearly commensurate with his rank, training, experience, and national reputation."

In regard to Evans' charges of discrimination in matters of promotion, the committee report states: 'The evidence presented indicates that his (Evans) services are highly valued in the contest of his own interpretation of his responsibility, but that his performance is regarded to be below average in terms of the interpretation of his responsibility by his immediate supervisors and most of his colleagues."
