Batchelder hits 'lawlessness'

UNL students are being exposed to "every form of human depravity" according to Clifton Batchelder of Omaha, a candidate for the Board of Regents. Batchelder said last week that the University administration is excessively permissive and has failed to solve problems facing the NU system,

Speaking in Omaha, Batchelder said "lawlessness and disorder on the campus have prevailed to the point where some students are afraid to go to the library in the evening for study or research." He said the University is beset with administrative and organizational problems which

are holding back its academic progress. The North Central Association of Colleges and Universities in its 1971 report on the status of accreditation of the University made 12 references to poor leadership, planning and organization, he said.
