"We felt the defense had to play outstanding the first few games because we knew the offense might have problems getting started," Kiffin said. "We weren't able to stop UCLA when we had to."

Texas A & M's Wishbone was impressive in the season opener against Wichita State. The Aggies scored a 36-13 win.

Junior Mark Green, who rushed for more than 160 yards last week, leads the Aggie offense from his left halfback slot. Freshman Earnest Bean, the most sought-after running back in Texas last year, is at right halfback.

The Wishbone offense is a natural for senior quarterback Lex James. James, who weighs 192, is a strong runner and


isn't afraid to carry the football.
