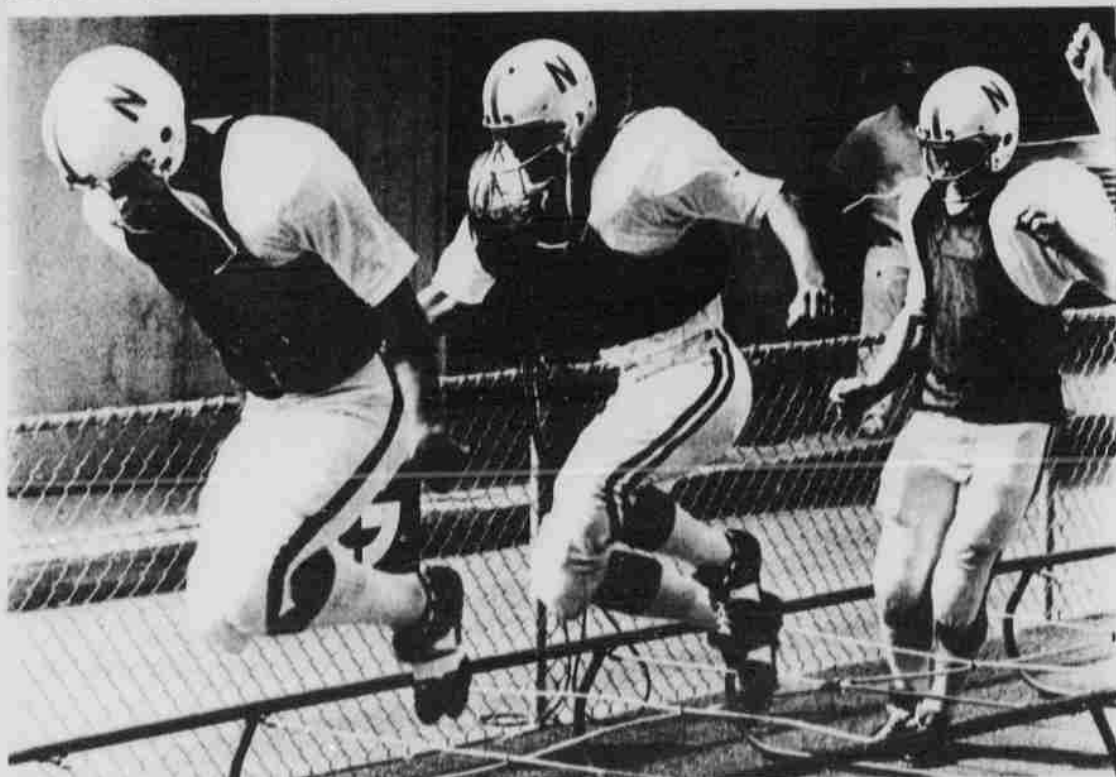
Defensive veterans Joe Blahak and Willie Harper have experienced what it is like to win as Nebraska varsity football players 24 times. They have lost only one game and tied another.
