


# Grand Opening Prizes

#### Student asks for CSL ag seat

Agriculture College student Phi Lamb told the Council on Student Life (CSL) Thursday night that he was not asking for immediate action, but relayed the concern and support of East Campus students for representation on CSL.

Petitions have been circulated to measure

that support, he reported.

It was found last week that amended CSL membership rules recommend one East Campus student be included on the council.

He further said he did not think the one CSL member from an East Campus living unit represented those colleges. That member, Bill Crom, is a pharmacy major.

"The people who use the facilities should be represented," Lamb said.


