## Ballots, mandates and power

"The purpose of this organization shall be to act as the supreme student governing body in the regulation and coordination of all phases of student self government and to serve as an agency through which the relationship between administration, faculty and students and between the general public and students may be maintained."

While the absence of election mandates has not made ASUN less of a government, it has most certainly caused the body to be less powerful than it should be.

Today is ASUN election day. It takes only 10 minutes to make an active commitment to the idea that the original purposes of ASUN should be fulfilled.
