

## Zumberge on KRNU

UNL Chancellor James Zumberge will answer questions about campus issues during "KRNU Forum" from 8 to 9 p.m. Tuesday, according to Peter Mayeux, UNL associate professor of journalism and KRNU program director.

The special phone-in program, which will be aired on the School of Journalism radio station, 90.3 fm, was scheduled after the April Board of Regents' meeting in order to get reactions to the meeting, Mayeux said.

It also is intended to provide the chancellor more contact with faculty and students, he said.

Questions should be phoned to 472-7211. Broadcasting students David Ahrendts and Meg Merchant will coordinate the program and ask the questions phoned in by listeners, Mayeux said.

Mayeux said a similar program will be aired May 16.



## Vets now qualify for scholarships

UNL student veterans are now eligible for the annual Edgar J. Boschult Memorial Scholarships, which were previously restricted to ROTC students.

The scholarships range from \$100 to \$125 per semester depending on the financial need of the recipient and the amount of money in the fund. The scholarships are supported by the Nebraska American Legion.

Veterans applying must have received honorable discharges and be full-time students at UNL. They also must have a satisfactory scholastic record, according to the agreement made by the University of Nebraska Foundation.

Additional qualifications for ROTC students include an aptitude for military or naval science and notable leadership abilities.

Selection of recipients will be made by the executive committee of the Nebraska American Legion.

In order to be eligible for the 1973-74 scholarships veterans must apply before May 1 at the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aids. ROTC students must apply at the Military and Naval Science Building in the office of their service.

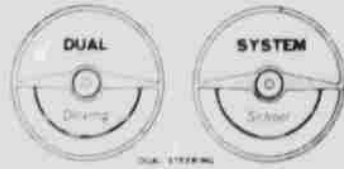
