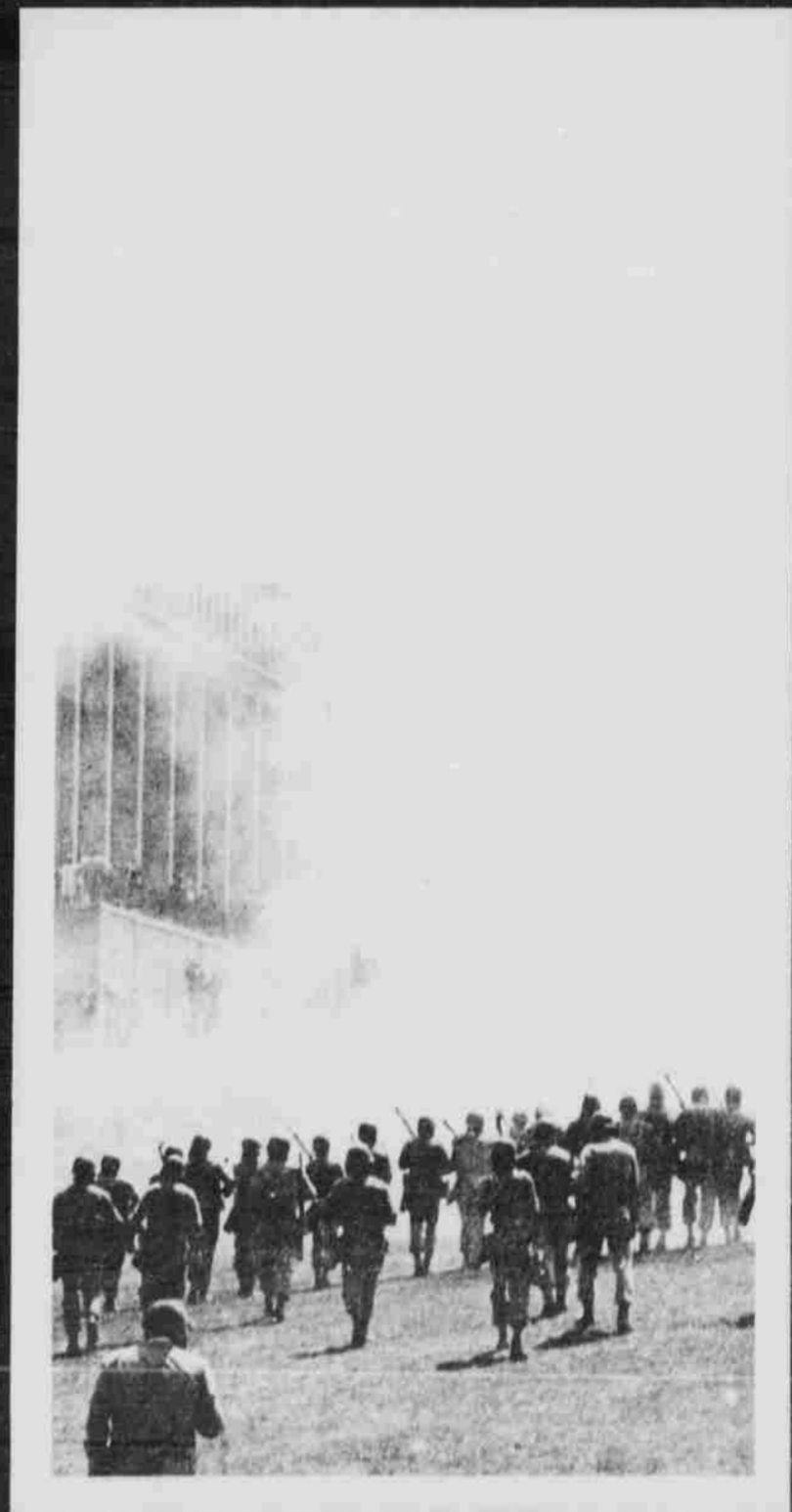




May 4, 1970



Three years ago today four Kent State University students were killed during a campus rally by Ohio National Guardsmen. Their deaths and subsequent deaths at Jackson State University set off nationwide student protests.

Not even Nebraska escaped the demonstrations that followed. After the shootings, a group of UNL students occupied the Military and Naval Science building to protest the Indo-China war and the students' deaths.
