

Full film schedule planned for Sheldon theatre in fall

The Sheldon Art Museum theatre will be busy this fall.

Dan Ladely, who was hired to manage the museum theatre, has lined up movies for six nights on some weeks this fall and he says students, faculty and staff can use the theatre at other times.

Ladely said a series of ten evenings of Charlie Chaplin movies will be shown on Friday and Saturday nights at 7 and 9 p.m. Admission will be \$1.25 for students, \$1.50 for non-students. Season tickets will be available to students for \$10 and to non-students for

The series will start with The Kid and Idle Class on Sept. 7 and 8. Season tickets will be available at Sheldon and probably the Union, Ladely said. Tickets also will be sold at

shown Oct. 9. "Henry V", made in 1944, will be shown Nov. 6. It stars Laurence Olivier, Robert Newoon, Leslie Banks, Renee Asherson and Esmond Knight.

Both films will be shown at 3, 7 and 9 p.m. and a \$1 admission will be charged.
