

Graduating seniors and graduate students interested in competing for grants in graduate study, research abroad or professional training in the creative and performing arts can apply for the Fulbright Hays Grant.

Students currently enrolled at UNL may get information and applications for the national competition from Roberto Esquenazi-Mayo, Fulbright program adviser, in Oldfather 1033. Campus deadlines for filing applications is October 1

Any student who is a U.S. citizen at the time of application and who will hold a bachelor's degree or its equivalent before the beginning date of the grant is eligible. In most cases the student should have a knowledge of the language of the country Esquenazi Mayo said.

Selection is based on the academic and/or professional record of the applicant, and the validity and content of his proposed study.
