is obviously one direction that will prove good," he said.

He said he does not think students have as great a feeling of counter establishment concerning the relevancy of classes that they had in the late '60s and early '70s, a feeling that might have urged them to participate more in NFU. This may be a reason for the decline in participation, he said.

"The success of the program depends on Howlett's ability to organize, publicize and let individuals know what is going on," Bader said. "If he has done this, I think his optimism toward the NFU is justified."

"I feel good about the publicity it is getting, the inquiries I have had from the community and the return of many courses to the dorms, he said.

The effects of his work will be unknown until tomorrow when NFU registration begins.

"Maybe out of desperation I'm being optimistic," he said.
