recent construction sites at Nebraska Hall and Oldfather Hall. Construction of a broad vending service is under way in Ferguson Hall and future plans are for a similar construction in the College of Business Administration Bldg.

Richard Bennett, director of special business services, said food products are not particularly profitable to sell from vending machines as far as the University is concerned. Calling such items a customer convenience, he said the University only receives a 5 per cent return on food sales.

Cold drinks appear to be the most profitable for the University with a 20 per cent return on sales. For other vending items, the University receives 10 per cent on all candy sales, 15 per cent on hot drinks, and 5 cents for each package of cigars.

Meerkatz said the present vending operation is "obviously providing a needed service" because of the volume of their use.

Bob Richeson, Union Food service manager, said an attempt is made to keep the Union's vended food on a comparable price level. He said prices in the cafeteria and machines are also generally the same.

The only variation in Union food, according to Richeson, is the size and price of hamburgers sold on home football game Saturdays. The food service director said football fans seem to like a larger size hamburger so the usual 35-cent price is increased to 65 cents by doubling the meat content.

All food sold in the Union's vending machines is prepared by food service personnel at the Union, Richeson said.

According to Christofferien, Automatic Merchandising food is prepared in Omaha and shipped to Lincoln.


