Local cafe features tasty fish dinners

I enjoy eating out. This may sound strange coming from a cook, but there are times when I don't want to dirty my hands, but would rather eat the product of another's ingenuity and labor.

However, I can't indulge often in eating out, because of the restraints of my budget. Therefore, I am constantly in search of restaurants that offer "something special" at a low price. One such establishment is the Greenwich Cafe.

The Greenwich Cafe is a bar and grill at 1917 G St. At first glance, it is not any different from 50 other Lincoln bars, except for the lighted sign in the window "FRIED CHICKEN". This is a reminder that one can eat as well as drink there.

On any night, the cafe's fried chicken is good and the drinks well-mixed, but on Friday nights, the Greenwich becomes "something special". On Friday nights The Greenwich Cafe serves the only palatable fish-and-chips in Lincoln.

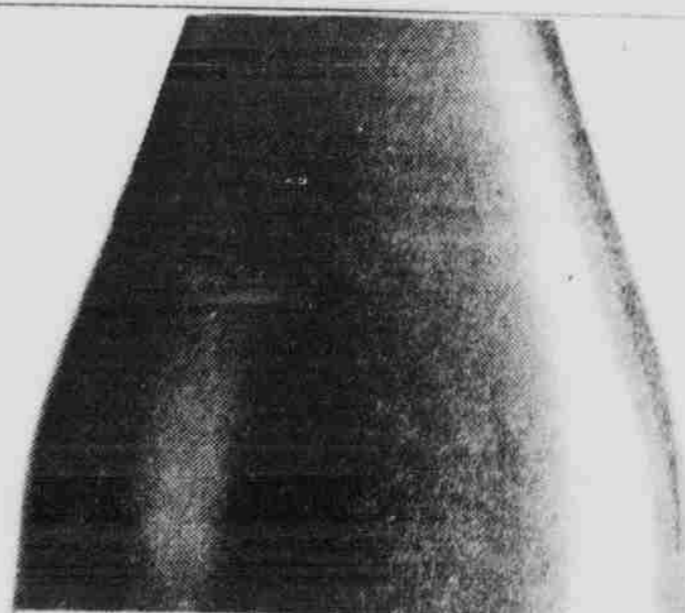

I fear that many students, when they hear "fish and chips" see visions of this dish as it is served in the university dormitories. That is consisting of a slab or two of flint, flavorless utility fish served with a mess of indifferent french fried potatoes.

This is not the case at the Greenwich. The fish is real, not reconstituted, and so has tenderness and taste that make it a delight to eat. It is dipped in batter, and deep-fat fried. The batter puffs up and browns, while the fish inside steam cooks in its own natural juices.

The result is a light non-greasy meal that settles easily upon the stomach. The fish is served with french fries, cooked up fresh for each order, assuring the diner of a hot pleasured.

The price of this treat? \$1.25, cash price, not including your drink. I suggest bringing along some friends, for good conversation enhances the flavor of fish and vinegar. This will make the evening completely enjoyable, and isn't that the best reason for eating out?
