Regents meet today

The NU Board of Regents is scheduled to re-examine possible acquisition of the former Hiram Scott College in Scottsbluff at their meeting today.

A final vote on whether to take control of the campus could come during the meeting, which is scheduled to begin at 2 p.m. in the NU Systems Bldg.

The regents have sought for a year to take the property without taxpayer cost, but have been stymied by opposition from the governor and a special committee report.

The board's property committee recently conducted a meeting at Scottsbluff to investigate using the location for an expanded University agricultural research program.

The regents are also scheduled to take action on a master contract for University life and health insurance programs.

Another item for consideration is salary raises of \$500 to \$2,000 for UNL's football coaches. Tom Osborne, head football coach, would have his annual salary raised from \$24,000 to \$26,000.

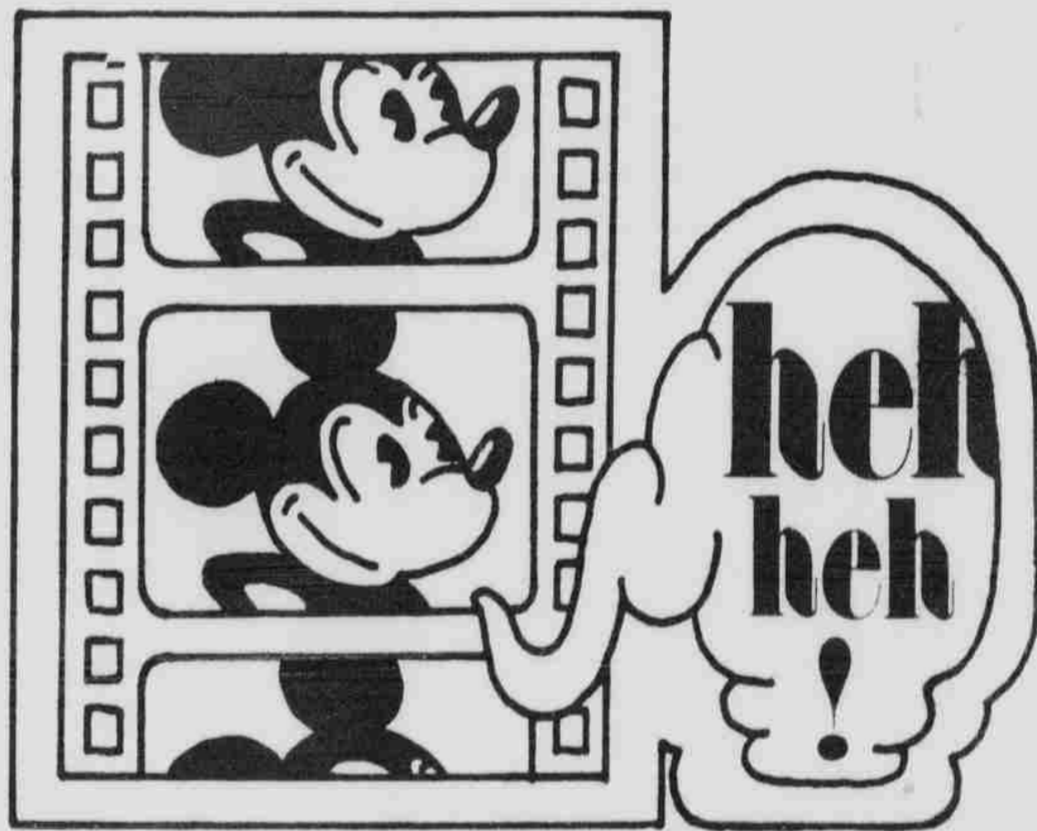
