It was announced to the senate that the ASUN Electoral commission had decided upon some clarifications of election rule procedures.

The commission has ruled that no campaign poster may be put up before March 3.

The commission also ruled that a student running for office to represent a college must be currently enrolled in that college. A student will be disqualified if he is not

currently enrolled in the college in which he is running for election, reported the commission.

This decision effects Dennis Martin and Robert Brehm, two students who have filed for election in the graduate and professional colleges, according to Sen. Sharon Johnson, who is running for first vice president on the United Student Effort ticket.

Since they are not currently members of the graduate college, they will not be allowed to run for the offices in that college, according to Sue Overing, ASUN second vice president and member of the electoral commission.
