

Impeach Nixon rally Saturday

"Rally to march and impeach Nixon!" command leaflets distributed by the Lincoln Coalition for the Impeachment of President Richard Nixon.

A smaller number of the leaflets advertising Saturday's rally and march were circulated than was planned, however, said UNL philosophy graduate Tom Manig, a member of the Coalition.

"This is a point of personal bitterness to me," he said. "We were allowed to leaflet only three dorms—Cather, Pound and Schramm."

To be allowed to leaflet the residence halls, the coalition first had to appear at each hall's government meeting to get permission. "I wasn't even allowed to take the floor during the Harper meeting," Manig said.

However, Manig predicted the rally, beginning at 1:30 p.m. on the north steps of the Capitol would be a success.

"We hope for a large crowd," said coalition member Sam Zeleski, "but if attendance is low it makes no difference—for the number that come we may have reached hundreds more in awareness."

Speaking at the impeachment rally will be State Sen. Steve Fowler, Rural Nebraskans for Peace President Merle Hansen, Dan Christensen of the Lincoln Gay Action Group, a representative of the *Nebraska Dispatch*, and UNL faculty members June Levine and Steve Buller.

Representatives from women's labor, Native American, Black and Chicano groups also have been invited.

Themes for the rally will be calls for impeachment of Nixon and demands to roll back fuel and food prices, stop aid and fuel oil to repressive regimes abroad and an end to repression at home.

"Our rally will be broadly based and nonpartisan," Manig said. "Unfortunately, many people believe impeachment is either a Democratic or liberal issue and we hope to show the public that decent minded citizens can see it makes sense."

Following the rally, a march will be held to the Woodman Accident and Life Insurance building to protest Woodman President J. Faulkner's leadership of the Nebraska Finance Committee to Re-elect the President. The group then will continue their march to Rep. Charles Thone's office to call on him to support impeachment.

"We've already been told he won't be there," Manig said.

Crossword Puzzle

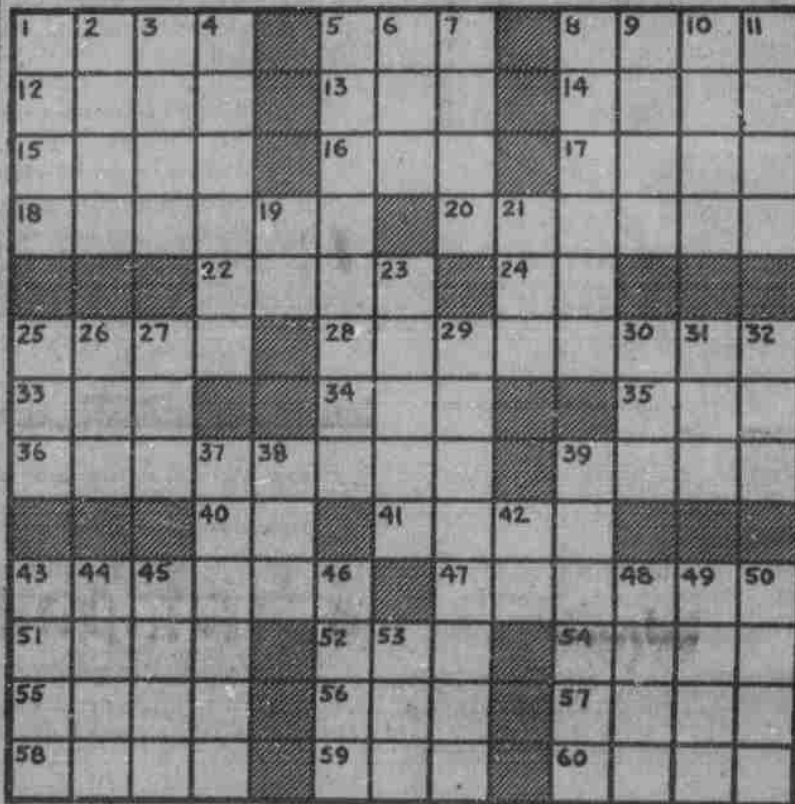
