

CSL defers fee appeal review

Student organizations that sought to appeal appropriations established last semester for the 1974-75 student fees budget may have another chance to be heard, according to a proposal discussed by the Council on Student Life (CSL) Thursday night.

At its first meeting this year, CSL discussed a review of the appeals procedure for recommendations made by the Fees Allocation Board. Some confusion existed among CSL members about who was to hear appeals last spring after the recommendations were made.

Dan Steller, CSL member and director of recreation, was a member of the allocation board. He told CSL the board understood that CSL was to hear appeals. Returning CSL members Mary Williams and Richard Armstrong said action taken last semester by CSL was to review an appeals procedure established by the allocation board.

The problem, some

members said, was that the board would be hearing appeals of its own recommendations. CSL member Ron Gierhan, assistant to the vice chancellor for student affairs, said the CSL action taken last semester seemed to imply the allocations board would not hear appeals but would be available for rehearing about appropriations it had made. CSL then would serve as the appeals body.

Dave Howlett, CSL student member, suggested that the council review an appeals procedure by the allocations board and possibly notify groups who sought to appeal last semester.

The council deferred action until after the board is reestablished this year.

Howlett expressed a concern that some groups may not have had adequate time to appeal because the allocations board's recommendations came so near the end of the semester.

In other business, CSL received reports completed last spring and during the summer.

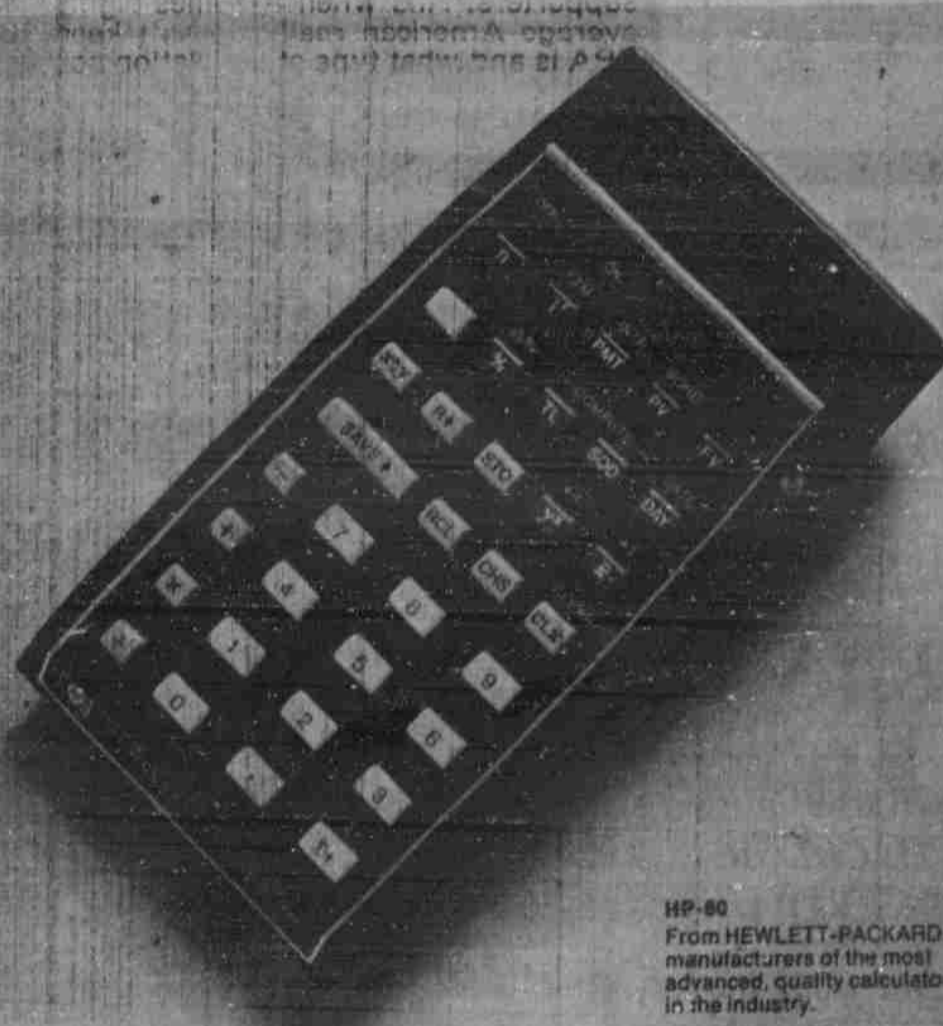
