Superpoll is back—but revised. This year's **Daily Nebraskan**-sponsored survey of student opinion is being conducted by Community Response, Inc. (CRI), an opinion research firm in Lincoln. In the past surveys had been mailed to students.

Superpoll IV is being conducted by four interviewers who are polling students at 40 campus locations, according to John Wood, CRI executive coordinator. The survey will be a proportional representation of UNL students according to class and major, Wood

said. Percentages of students interviewed are based on UNL enrollment figures, he said.

Wood said the interviews should be completed by the end of the week. Results of the poll will be published in the **Daily Nebraskan**.

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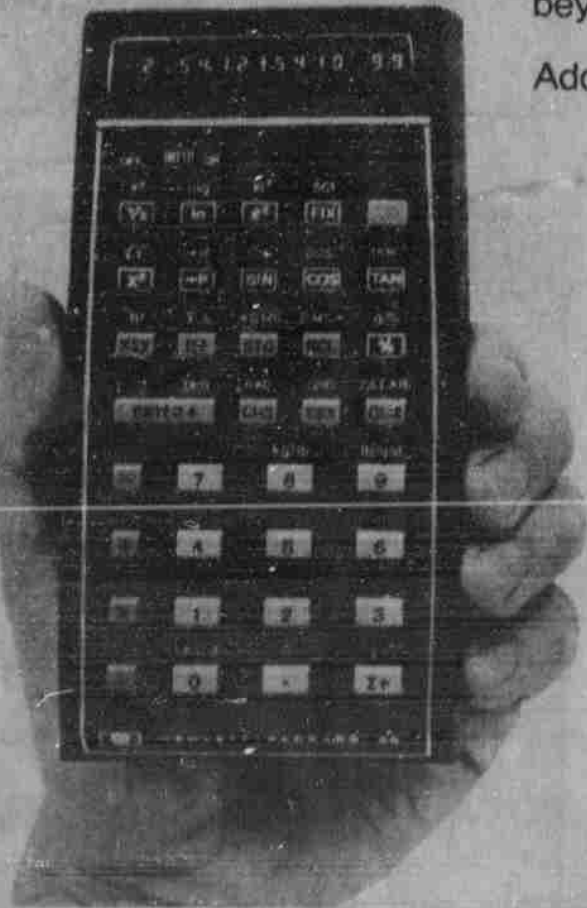
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
