James C. Olson, chancellor of the University of Missouri, Kansas City. A widely acclaimed Nebraska historian, Olson has served in a variety of positions at NU. He has written several books and articles on the topic of Nebraska History. Centennial College will host an informal discussion with Olson at 1:30 p.m. Friday.
