Constable, Gericault in art film

The fifth installment of Lord Kenneth Clark's most recent film series, "Romantic versus Classic Art," is showing this weekend at the Sheldon Film Theater. This weekend's offering will deal with painters John Constable and Theodore Gericault.

Constable, an English romantic artist, found his inspiration in nature, which he regarded with an almost religious awe. Unlike fellow romantic William Turner, who saw nature as a force both violent and destructive, Constable saw her as the source of all good. Often referred to as the first modern painter, Constable anticipated by nearly half a century the discovery of the creative uses of light.

Gericault, on the other hand, typified all that was dark and seamy about romanticism. Gericault considered Nalure perverse and destructive. Ironically, he died of a mysterious illness at 33.

The films begin at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday, and at 3 p.m. Sunday, and are open to the public with no admission charge.

The film's eerily made-up zombies and somewhat contrived plotlines make it almost a throwback to the '40s, although certainly much more explicit in its horror.




Glee clubs present 'Big Sing' tonight
