IFC post to Eveland

The Interfraternity Council (IFC) elected sophomore art major Al Eveland president at its Wednesday night meeting. Eveland, a member of Delta Tau Delta fraternity, defeated Jim Yanney from Alpha Tau Omega and Todd McDaniel of Delta Upsilon for the office.

Also slated for installation in two weeks are Phil Woodburn of Farmhouse, vice president; Jim Scheer of Phi Gamma Delta, treasurer; and Eric Chapman of Sigma Alpha Epsilon, secretary.

Eveland handles kick-off chores for the fifth-rated, Cornhusker football team.

Prior to his election, Eveland proposed three ideas to involve more individuals from the fraternities in IFC activities.

His plans include providing more service to fraternity houses and their members, holding seminars for committees and house officers and holding an IFC executive board exchange with other schools to gain ideas for IFC improvement.

Eveland said "IFC is powerful enough as a unit to bring pressure to bear" if the organization's campus position and relationship with the administration was jeopardized.

A \$3.25 assessment for fraternity members also was approved to provide operating expenses for IFC, expenses for IFC.
