Dial-a-job line initiated

Inspired by dial-a-prayer and dial-a-horoscope, the University of Nebraska Medical Center's six week old "dial-a-job" has met with "a fantastic response" according to Larry Peterson, medical center personnel manager.

A call to 541-4446 in Omaha gives a tape recorded message of current job opportunities open at the medical center for the week. The jobs may range from chest physiotherapy technician to laundry supervisor.

The program began in early December, Peterson said. It replaces the medical center job advertising in the Sunday Omaha World-Herald with just one notice telling job-seekers where to call, Peterson said.

Peterson estimates the number is called an average of once every five minutes.

"There is no question that there has been an increase in the number of job applicants because of the system," Peterson said.

A similar system was used at the UNL financial aids office for several months, according to director Jack Ritchie. The recording listed part-time jobs for students but was discontinued about a month ago because "we weren't really getting our money's worth," Ritchie said.

The office now keeps a list of current job openings. Other job listings are available in the UNL personnel department.
