

Outdoor events stressed

Discover the great outdoors. That's what Mark Eble wants to help students with. Eble has been appointed coordinator of outdoor programs in the UN-L office of recreation.

"I intend to become a resource person and help provide all the information I can about wilderness activities," Eble said.

Eble, whose last home was

Carbondale, Ill., also intends to set up some organized outdoor activities such as backpacking trips.

Eble's past experience ranges from leading high school students on a 63 day tour of the western United States for two summers, to managing a sporting goods shop.

Nebraska is somewhat deficient in the availability of

wilderness sports sights, Eble said.

He pointed to lack of public land in Nebraska that can be used for wilderness activities. The Nebraska National Forest in the northwest corner of the state is about the only wilderness area, he said.

Eble said he has tentatively planned a backpacking trip for students during August.

Faculty orientation planned

A welcome and orientation to UN-L will be held for new faculty members August 20.

An afternoon workshop coordinated by the Teaching and Learning Center is planned to help acquaint new teachers with University procedures.

Discussion groups will be lead by current

Harding said the date for the workshop has been set early so departments could coordinate any orientation programs they are planning with the general one.

The workshop will also provide an opportunity for the new faculty to get to know each other, Harding said.

Roger Welsch, assistant professor of English, will speak about Nebraska history and folklore at the evening meal.
