Photographs at Sheldon

Thirty-six black and white photographs by Vincent Vallarino will be on display in the Sheldon Memorial Art Gallery through Oct. 5.

ducks, loons and a great horned owl, will be shown through Oct. 5, Nelson said.

The photographs are of southern Iceland, said Jon Nelson, assistant director of the gallery.

"The American Indians, as far as anybody knows, were the first to make bird decoys," Nelson said. "It really is a native American art form."

Two photographs are of a recent volcano eruption on an island near Iceland, Nelson said, and most are nature scenes.

No American Indian decoys are displayed, however. A 1,000-year-old decoy from the Museum of the American Indian in New York City was supposed to be sent to Sheldon, but the New York attorney general decided nothing should leave the museum, Nelson said.

"The Bird Decoy: An American Art Form" is displayed in the upstairs north wing of Sheldon. About 300 decoys of several kinds of birds, including geese,

The display does have decoys made as early as the 19th century, he said.
