HEARTS AND MINDS
 (Best Documentary)

Documentary films have a poor record in commercial theatres. However, the management of the Hollywood Theatre has licensed an engagement of "Hearts and Minds" in spite of the previous track record of such films. In an era of bicentennial celebration, we cannot forget the "rhetoric of the effete corps of snobs," peace with honor, napalm, peace marches, sit-ins, campus riots, Kent State, Eugene McCarthy, draft dodgers, Jane Fonda, peace signs, Viet Cong, Tet Offensive, DMZ, Calley, My Lai, ROTC, doves, hawks, Westmoreland, Cam Ranh Bay, Diem, LBJ, Nixon, Rusk, McNamara, Agnew - the names, the events, the slogans, all were an integral part of day-to-day living during an era forgotten by many. The film's maker, Peter Davis ("The Selling of the Pentagon") has taken 150 hours of footage and reduced it to 112 minutes of the most intense film ever produced. We do not take a stand on the merits of the film politically or morally; we merely present the film in its entirety.
