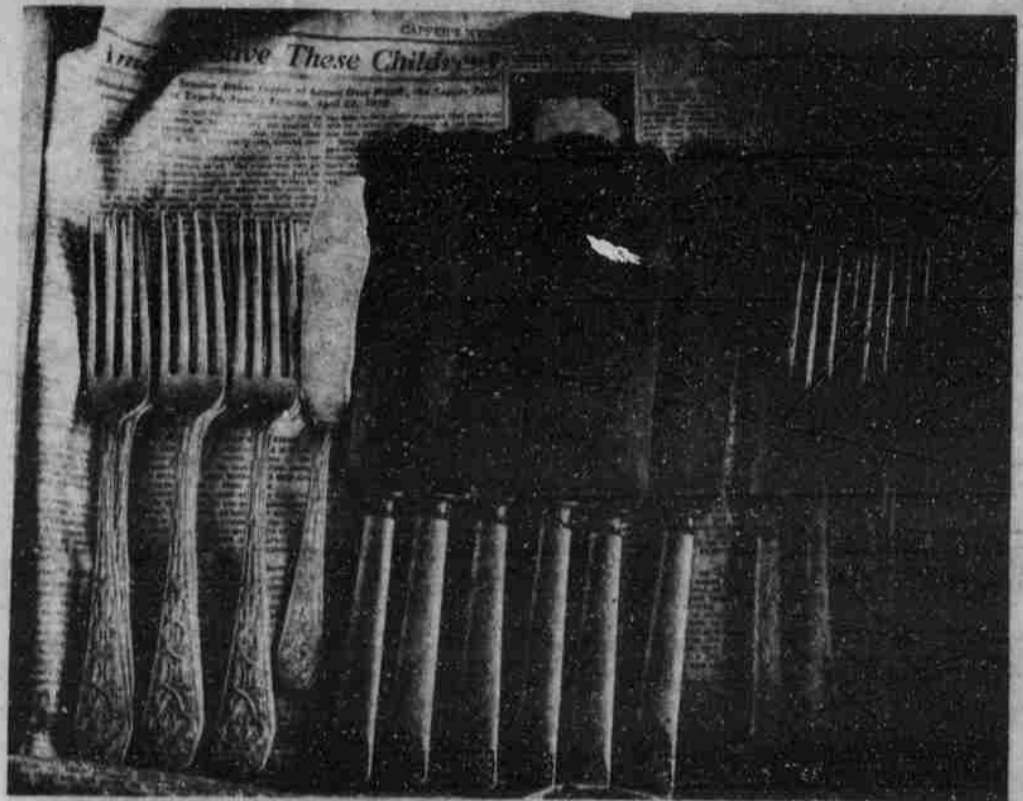
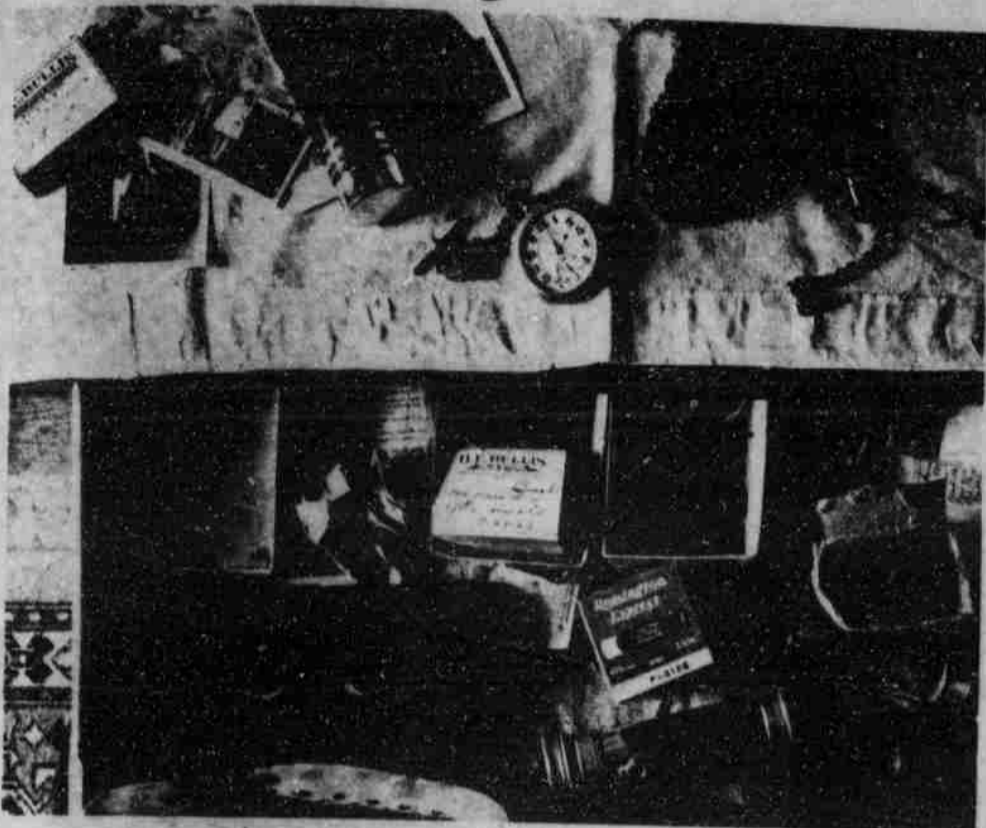


Wright Morris



Photographs by Wright Morris are on exhibit in Sheldon Memorial Art Gallery until Nov. 16. *Structures and Artifacts: Photographs 1933-1954* is the exhibit's title and of a catalogue describing the show available in Sheldon's Art Shop.
