Dentistry students taking pressures

UNL's College of Dentistry has begun a program to check blood pressures as patients are accepted at the dental clinic, said Dr. William Ahrens.

Within the last two months, students have recorded the blood pressure of 1,500 patients, Ahrens said.

Although blood pressure has been checked prior to oral surgery for the past 20 years, and has been part of compiling medical histories for the last three years, the number of recordings has increased considerably this fall, he said.

Sophomores and older dental students now are issued a stethoscope and blood pressure cuff, and specific blanks are included on medical histories, he said.

Because dentists see their patients more often than others in the medical field, they may be able to detect high blood pressure sooner, he said.

The importance of early detection of high blood pressure recently has been emphasized by the allied health profession nationwide.

"No diagnosis or treatments are made here," Ahrens said, adding that dental treatment is not continued until the patient is treated.

Ahrens said no statistics have been kept on the number of patients referred to doctors because of blood pressure readings.

Patients also are checked periodically while being treated at the clinic and always before especially stressful situations, he said.
