Twenty-one UNL students were honored Wednesday evening for their election to Phi Beta Kappa, national liberal arts and sciences honorary.

New members were introduced at a Phi Beta Kappa banquet where Sen. Richard Marvel spoke on "The Intellectual in Politics," and Stanley Vandersall, UNL professor of classics, spoke on the history of UNL's Phi Beta Kappa chapter.

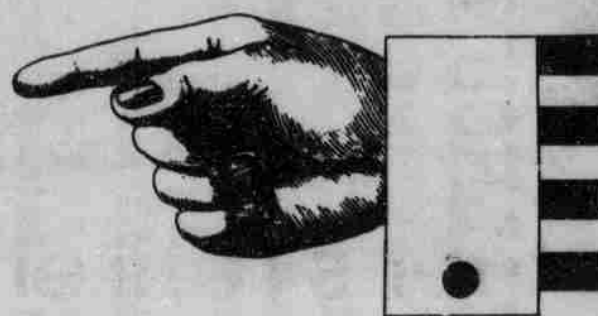
